We will arrange a SIG meeting at the next ARLE conference at the University of Melbourne, Australia, 2024. Here we will make the final decision on whether we should continue as an autonomous SIG or rather consider ourselves as going *across* the other SIGs. For example, we have discussed whether our mission in an ARLE context would be better met if we instead form a kind of "cluster" across SIGs in L1. A way of maintaining our dialogic focus could be to gather news, distribute ideas and research. We would be happy to have the role as media and meeting place for us to share and find others with the dialogic education interest that make possible setting up symposia among us in other SIG-seminars and conferences and maybe writings, articles, special issues and the like.
